1. <b>Declarations of Members' Interests</b> – Cllr Hansford declared an interest in the discussion relating to 67, Main Street. Cllr Roberts declared an interest in the discussion relating to 2, Meadowgate. Both councillors withdrew for the relevant points.

3. <b>PUBLIC TIME</b> – a neighbour to 67, Main Street came to advise council of the contents of his letter of objection. His main complaints were that the application is retrospective, has been submitted without consultation, includes incorrect information, negatively impacts the skyline and landscape, is damaging to wildlife & imposes bright lights on his property. The owner of 67, Main Street assured council that the lights are designed to be easily dismantled.	
4. <b>PLANNING</b> – Cllr Hansford withdrew <b>67, Main Street</b> – To be returned with an objection to the installation of lighting. Cllr Hansford returned & Cllr Roberts withdrew <b>2, Meadowgate</b> – no objection	<b>LH</b>
